Acknowledgement of Country

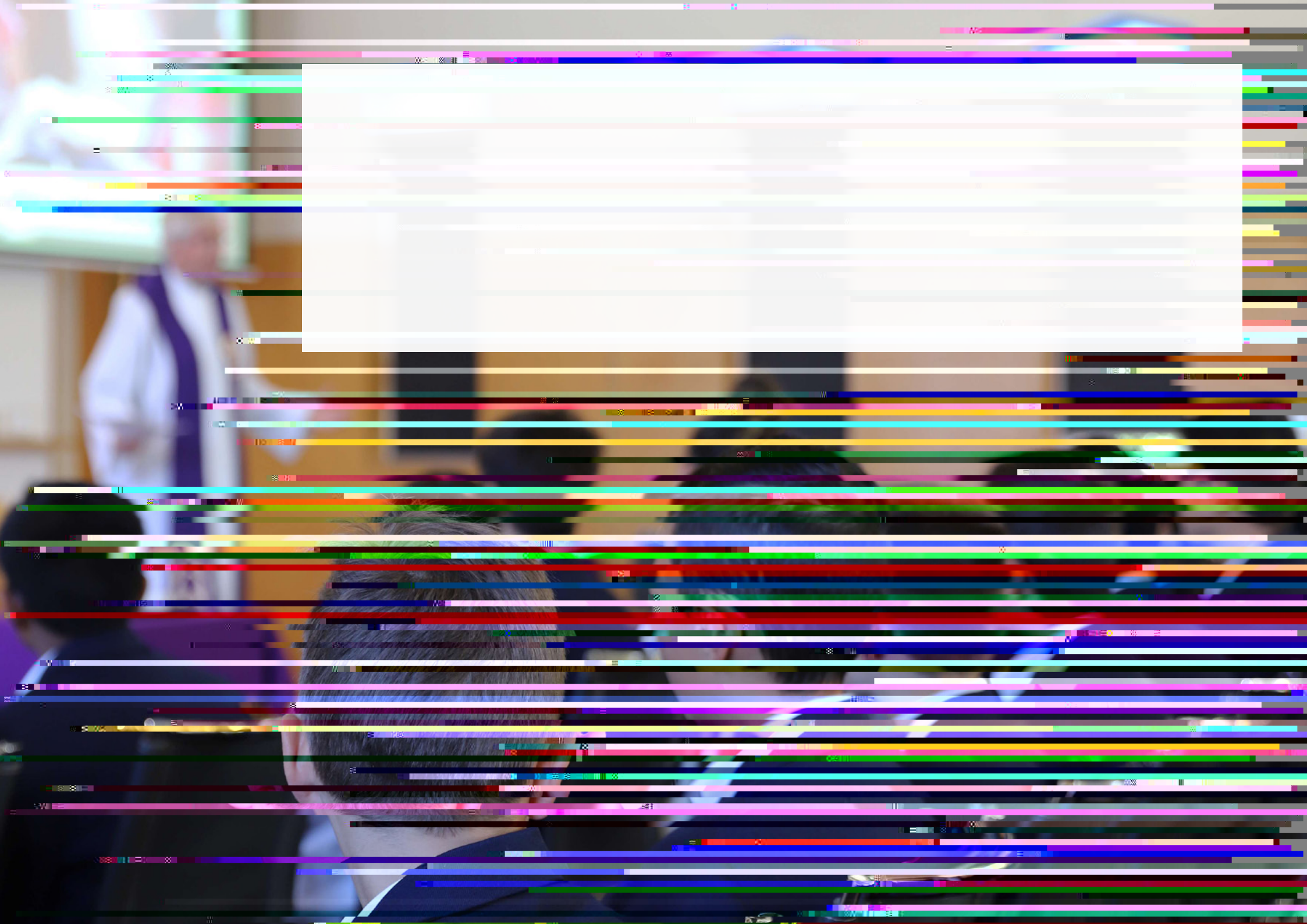

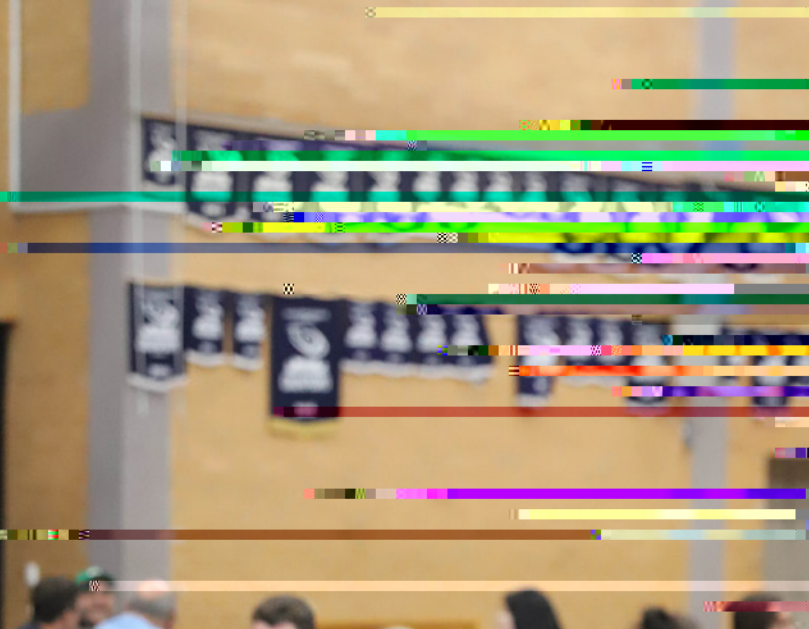
We believe our Salesian Charism is a gift that provides the College with a point of difference.

Explore dialogue and actions to listen, learn, understand and respond to the dignity of all with respect.

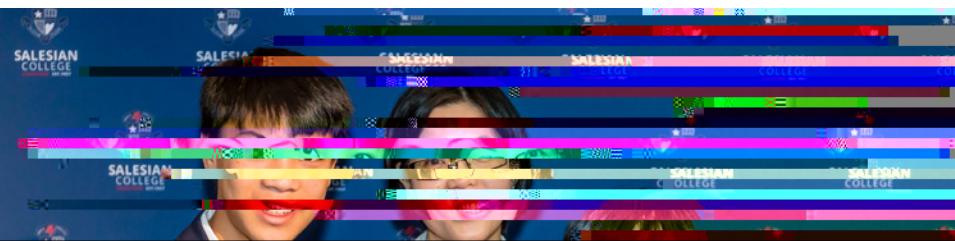
Encourage subsidiarity in leadership by sharing dynamic approaches to strategy, innovation and operations that animate our Vision, Mission and Values.

At Salesian College Chadstone, we are committed to creating a sense of welcome and belonging

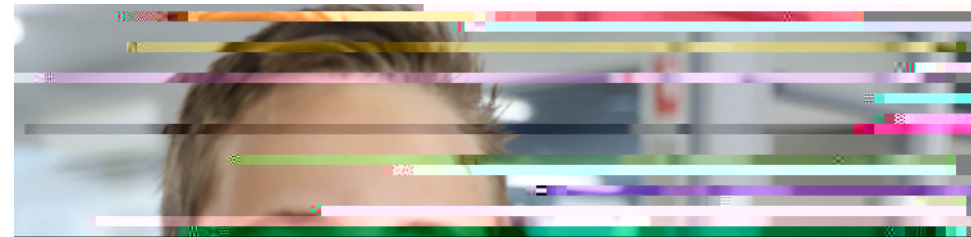
OUR COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIPS
